

Accreditation Placement Rate Methodology

A graduate from the graduation cohort is considered eligible for placement unless they meet one of the seven exemptions detailed below:

- a. The graduate is deceased
- b. The graduate has a permanently or indefinite disability
- c. The graduate or graduate's spouse was deployed for military service/duty
- d. The graduate becomes incarcerated within six (6) months of completion of the program
- e. The graduate studied under a student visa and is ineligible for employment in the U.S.
- f. The graduate continued his/her education at an institution under the same ownership of a NACCAS approved program
- g. COVID-19 Exemptions and Restricted Variances as described in Appendix B of the 2022 Data Annual Report (Submitted in 2023) Instructions

The Salon Professional Academy includes students in the Placement Rate as employed by November 30 following the cohort in the Gainful Employment template.

State Placement Rate Methodology

Graduates will be considered employed in a related field if the skills obtained through the curricular training are essential and necessary for the employment. Students who have dropped, been terminated by the school, or have ceased instruction in the program by any other manner (e.g. transferred to another curriculum at the school) during the reporting period of July 1st to June 30th are considered ineligible for placement.

The Salon Professional Academy includes students in the Placement Rate as employed in their field by April 15th of reporting year.
